Instructions

1. Audio will be through a regular teleconference line. Please start by dialing in to the number below, and enter in the Conference ID number.

2. The video and presentation will be broadcast through Blackboard Collaborate, a web-based service. The software will download a file to your computer, but does not require special permissions or programs to run.

To view the speakers and presentation on the day of the meeting:

- i. Turn off your computer speakers—you will not need them.
- ii. Click on the following link:

- iii. Follow the prompts to download the Blackboard Collaborate program.
- iv. Select your connection speed – usually Cable or Wireless.
- v. A window will open with a purple header that says “Blackboard Collaborate”.
- vi. Type your first and last name and your local government in the “Session Login” box – this is how you will be identified during the webinar.
- vii. Click the “Log In” button.
- viii. Type a “hello” or greeting in the chat box on the lower left.
