




Proportion of Renter Households Spending Over 30% of Income on Shelter in BC, 2016

64% of renter households led by <u>single</u> <u>mothers</u> are over the recommended affordability benchmark






Proportion of Renter Households Led by Single Mothers Spending Over 30% of Income on Shelter in BC, 2016






Proportion of Renter Households Led by Seniors Spending Over 30% of Income on Shelter in BC, 2016











B Homelessness in BC (Per Capita)




