



Host Community Agreements

Assists with addressing some of the challenges:

Not in my back yard – incredibly challenging to site waste management facilities;

Ministry of Environment regulations - challenging to meet, costly to implement, non-compliance no longer an option;

RDs exempt from paying municipal taxes; grant-in-lieu.

Provides acknowledgement to the community 'host' for the location of a significant greater regional environmental facility:

A partnership approach to managing operations and addressing community concerns;

A financial approach to addressing infrastructure impacts and ongoing maintenance/other community concerns;

A legal approach to provide for inclusiveness, enforceability and accountability.

Concerns raised by Village of Cumberland regarding landfill siting Comox Strathcona (2010 prior to SWMP approval)

No evidence of first nations consultation;
Landfill location not compatible with long term development plans;
Request to explore other options for "Regional Facility";
Regional Landfill will add to existing environmental and logistical problems;
Concerns of pollution and proximity of water source;
Deterioration, illegal dumping, litter and pollution of roads;
Decreased property values.

Waste Management
February 14, 2013 – board authorizes host community agreement, subject to obtaining elector approval from residents.

20 year agreement, key components (2013 – December 31, 2032):
EXISTING ROADWAYS REHABILITATION AND PROVISTIONS:

one time upgrade to the traffic corridor;
MOTI standards for design and construction;
ont to exceed \$3,000,000.00;
HOST COMMUNITY RATE FEE: Host community rate fee of \$300,000.00 per annum;
REVIEW: Mandatory joint review every five years commencing 2020;
COMMUNICATION: parties agree to meet no less than once per calendar year to review matters relating to the agreement.
