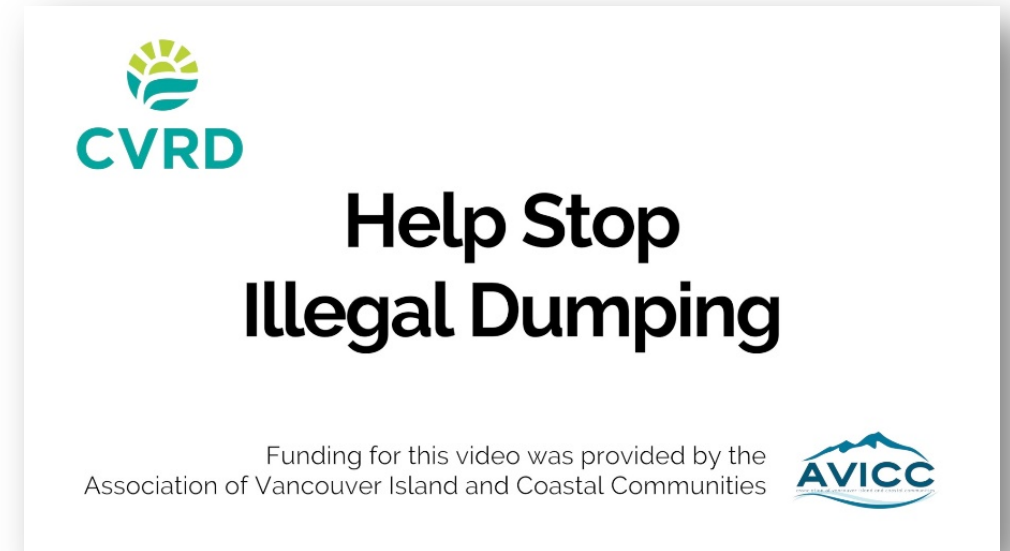
Communications Collaboration
