Fire Safety Act

Areas of Interest:

Inspections

- No new requirement to inspect
- Powers under the Act
- Ability to inspect/investigate
- Direct appointments vs. LAFC

Compliance Monitoring

1. Where does C.M. apply?
2. What aspects do not apply?

Administrative Penalties

1. Orders by inspectors
2. Inspectors request penalties
3. Issuance of penalties
4. Reviews (appeals) by Fire Commissioner

1. Tactical

2. Preventive evacuations

- ✓ Timeline for legislation?
