

2019 UBCM Convention – Series of Resolutions Articles

Article #1 - What is a Resolution?

A resolution is a “request” being made by a local government to another order of government or another organization, e.g. RCMP, BC Hydro. Resolutions can address nearly any topic, with a request for something (i.e. requesting support, more funding, changes to legislation, etc.)

All local government/First Nations members of UBCM are entitled to submit resolutions for consideration by the membership at the annual UBCM Convention in September. Members authoring those resolutions are the sponsor.

The resolution, if endorsed by the majority of the membership, is conveyed by UBCM to the other orders of government or other organization(s) that the resolution is the focus of the request.

Upon receipt the other orders of government or other organization(s) consider the request and provide a response, which UBCM analyses and shares with the sponsor and with the entire UBCM membership through their web site.
