

2019 UBCM Convention – Series of Resolutions Articles

Article #10 - Late Resolutions – Must be New or Emergency for Admission

A late resolution is one that is submitted directly to UBCM after the June 30 submission deadline and before noon on the Friday before Convention. In 2019, that will be noon on Friday, September 20.

UBCM accepts all late resolutions received within that period of time and will publish them in the Report on Resolutions Received After the Deadline (Policy Book 2). This blue covered Policy Book 2 is given to each member when they register at Convention.

The Resolutions Committee applies criteria to determine which of three possible recommendations should be proposed for each late resolution:

- **Admit for Debate** - If it is a new, emergency resolution, meaning this topic arose following the June 30 submission deadline.
- **Not Admit for Debate** - If it is a resolution on a topic that arose or was known before the June 30 deadline.
- **Refer to UBCM Executive** - If it is a resolution on a topic that arose following the June 30 deadline, but is not emergency, not controversial and is in keeping with UBCM policy.

The Report of Resolutions Received After the Deadline, which contains the late resolutions will be considered during the resolutions plenary on Friday morning.
