

Article #7 Attachment - How to Vote for Resolutions and What are the Percentages Required to Endorse?

The percentage thresholds required for each type of voting is as follows:

Simple Majority (50%)	Three-Fifths Majority (60%)
Endorsement of an individual resolution	Endorsement of an Extraordinary Resolution (ER) (or endorsement of an amended ER)
Approve a proposed amendment to an individual resolution	Consideration of an Off-The-Floor resolution
Consideration of a Block of resolutions	Approve and/or amend and approve the Report on Resolutions Received After The Deadline (Policy Book 2)
Endorsement of a Block of resolutions	
Approve a proposed amendment to a Block of resolutions (to pull one or more for individual consideration)	
Endorsement of an Off-The-Floor resolution (that was previously approved to be considered with a 60% majority)	
Approve a proposed amendment to an ER resolution	
Withdrawal of a resolution by the sponsor
