Operationalizing Asset Management Cohort

- Purpose is to understand and address barriers to implementing AM
- Create a Cohort of interested local governments
 - Bring together local governments at various stages of AM maturity
 - Includes a series of face to face workshops and webinars
 - Travel/expenses included
- Address implementation challenges like communication, organizational structure, culture, strategic plan alignment, staff capacity, etc.

Level of Service Regional Workshops
