ADVANCE MEDIA REGISTRATION NOW OPEN FOR ACCESS TO 2020 UNION OF BC MUNICIPALITIES VIRTUAL CONVENTION September 22 to 24, 2020

RESOLUTIONS BOOK IS NOW AVAILABLE ONLINE

Victoria, B.C. (August 19, 2020) – Registration is open for members of the news media wishing to cover the 117th annual Union of British Columbia Municipalities Convention. This year's convention will be held over three days in a virtual, live-streaming format available to UBCM delegates and media across the province. No media will be able to attend any of the sessions in person this year due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

All media representatives wishing to view the virtual convention's sessions and other proceedings must register in advance to obtain approved accreditation and login details to access the streaming program.

UBCM president Maja Tait, mayor of the District of Sooke will preside over the convention, bringing to a close her one-year term. The incoming president, Councillor Brian Frenkel of the District of Vanderhoof, was acclaimed July 31, 2020 and will be installed on the final day of the convention.
