## **Snapshot of B.C. Seniors**



#### **Seniors population**

- **58%** (592,00) aged 65-74
- **30%** (302,000) at 75-84
- **12%** (122,000) at 85+



**95%** aged 65+ live independently

- **9%** 85+ live in assisted living
- **13%** 85+ live in long-term care



**80%** aged 65+ are homeowners










- **17%** aged 55-64 live alone
- 21% at 65-74
- **27%** at 75-84
- **39%** at 85+
- **88%** have driver's license at age 65
  - **58%** at age 85
  - **40%** at 85+
  - 20% at 90+

**\$34,000** median income of 65+ (\$47,600 avg.)




