July through December 2022

- Update/familiarize working group members with provincial or joint provincial-local initiatives addressing the cost drivers and fiscal trends included in the UBCM 2021 report, to identify whether additional work or research is required to consider the report's recommendations;
  - Establish metrics and/or identify sources of metrics to monitor trends or shifts in local government revenues or costs stemming from economic patterns known generally as the 'New Economy'; and
  - Continue support for ongoing partnerships between Province and UBCM to align provincial and local government interests in negotiations with the federal government.
