




# What you should know

#### Housing is a priority!

- The Housing Action Taskforce has been created;
  - A single window and navigation service for housing proponents went live on March 31<sup>st</sup> – we are moving towards a process that is coordinated, transparent and efficient;
  - Additional resources have (and continue to be) hired to support permitting for housing activities;
- Dashboard created in government to support improved insight into application backlog.
- There is more work to be done

### Housing Action Taskforce




Purpose Provide dedicated and coordinated oversight and solutions for provincial authorizations as it relates to housing navigation service delivery, information technology systems, project management and policy support.



### **Single Application**



WHAT IT IS

Initially the single application will support a "registry" and potential application types will be identified to the user - over time the single application will be built to integrate the existing separate applications into a singular application to complete and submit.

WHAT IT WILL DO Initially – the Single Application will reduce duplication of common fields of information such as name, address, and initially be capable of identifying common application types for housing.

Longer term – "UPS-like" tracking visible to applicants, with "smart" features built in over time.
