

PENTICTON IS GROWING

The City has many exciting housing projects proposed, approved or under construction. The following is a snapshot of these projects which are helping to address the need for housing in the community.



The City has received applications for 654 apartments **PROPOSED** and residential lots. These applications are currently being processed and are not yet approved.

- 877 Westminster Ave W 300 strata rental units and ground floor commercial
- 2 650 Eckhardt Ave W - 6 storey with 70 units and ground floor commercial
- 206 Marina Way 10 storey with 99 strata units 3
- 603 Main St 5 storey with 28 rental units and ground floor commercial 4
- 655 Ellis St 3 storey with 16 units 6
- 6 914 Churchill Ave - 6 storey with 16 units
- 1050 Spiller Rd 111 rural residential lots
- 1530 Reservoir Rd 30 rural residential lots R

The City has 840 townhomes, duplexes or APPROVED apartments approved and ready to build.




- 128 respondents representing301 new residents
