- 4. Determine what activities to undertake.





- 5. Allocate a small budget as necessary for prizes or other promotional materials.
- 6. Invite local partners to participate, such as schools, local businesses, and organizations.
- 7. Talk to local government peers to find opportunities to collaborate, such as between regional districts and municipalities, boards of education, and First Nations.
- 8. Engage with the media in your community, and invite them to cover the activities during the week.
- 9. Promote activities to the public, inviting participation and engagement.
